Cervical plates are part of an instrumentation system, which provides the surgeon with specialized tools to perform a precision fit. The plates are manufactured to conform to the contour of the spine. When the plate requires adjustment, a contouring tool is used to customize the fit to the patient's cervical anatomy.

The plates are made with screw holes through which screws anchor the plates onto the vertebral body. The plate prevents the interbody space from opening when the patient bends backwards. This reduces loosening of the interbody cages and helps to prevent fusion disruption. Sometimes, anterior plates are placed at the L4-L5 level.

Cerebrospinal fluid is produced by a specialized tissue called the choroid plexus. Choroid plexuses are located in the walls of the lateral ventricles and in the roofs of the third and fourth ventricles. A choroid plexus shows numerous villi, via which it secretes the cerebrospinal fluid. Structurally, each villus consists of three components;

Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) studies demonstrated no damage to the spinal cord or C5-6 vertebral discs. Surgery was performed two days after the fall. Posterior fusion using an S-plate was performed with local bone grafting. The screws of the S-plate were inserted through the spinous processes of C5, C6, and C7 (Fig. (Fig.1b). 1b).
